- 12" trimmer
- archival ink pad - jet black
- sponge applicator
- paper scissors
- paper piercer
- journaling pen - black
- foam tape
- small guillotine
- archival ink pad - coffee
- glossy accents
- detail scissors
- piercing mat
- journaling pen - brown
- various adhesives*

* adhesives including double sided tape, tape runner, mini glue dots, and glue pen

Using the gorgeous 'Lost & Found 2 – Sunshine' range from My Mind's Eye, you will create two single page layouts. Kat has used negative space with just the right number of embellishments to create classic styled pages. The yellow, black and cream tones of this range will allow you to use a wide range of photos. You will be introduced to the 'Elegant Edges' Cricut cartridge to create gorgeous embellishments.

This single layout class is heavy on technique and you will be pleased with the final result. You will emboss, sand, fold and stitch your way through this class and be introduced to the very useful Cricut 'Birthday Bash' cartridge.

(class sample is colour but black & white is fine)

Tool kit: basic kit plus sewing needle to thread DMC (6 strand thick), craft mat and sanding block.

Note: class sample has used Prima Alphabet stickers – but something similar can be substituted.

(we provide papers, cardstock, button, DMC thread and workshop tools such as border punch, bigshot machine, embossing folders, cricut machine, cricut cartridge/s, sew easy tool & heads)

The classic tones and patterns of Basic Grey's 'Picadilly' range are the focus of this double page class. Using the red and blue tones with just the right amount of cream cardstock you will create a layout perfect to celebrate older members of the family or as Kat as done – using black and white photos will work with current photos of yourself and your children. You will do a small amount of hand-stitching, team it with subtle inking, glimmer mist, make a handmade canvas flower and use a title taken from the 'Teresa Collins Sophisticated Cricut' cartridge in order to complete this class.

- stitch templates
- canvas

1 x 6x4 portrait, feature - black and white good!
 2 x 5x3 portrait (cut down from 6x4 size in class)
 2 x 5x3 landscape (cut down from 6x4 size in class)

Tool kit: basic kit plus sewing needle to thread DMC (6 strand thick).

(we provide papers, cardstock, canvas, DMC thread, glimmer mist and workshop tools like cricut machine with cartridge/s, bigshot machine and dies)

Our Cricut cartridge focus for this class in 'Mini Monsters' – create the cutest monster embellishments around in this class.
